

First of all I would like to thank the AADO organization for organizing such a fellowship programme for the Asian doctors. I would also like to extend my sincere gratitude towards Dr. Shen W Y and his trauma team for the hospitality and care that I received here at Queen Elizabeth Hospital.

This fellowship has definitely given me some new dimensions for planning and management while dealing in fractures. There are many things that I saw and learned here were very useful and can easily be utilized back home without making much changes to the preexisting system. During the course of my fellowship we discussed different types of fractures and learned various methods and tricks to improve the quality, timing and outcome of the surgery.

Things were very well coordinated with me right from the beginning. Mrs. Kellan C was very prompt in paper work and responding to queries. The PowerPoint presentation sent to me by Dr. K B Lee and Dr. Shen W Y were very informative and handy.

To further improve the management of the course I would like to suggest a few things-

I would like to make a point that at least a gap of two months should be there between confirmation of fellowship and beginning of the fellowship. This time window is important, especially in Indian context, where we have to arrange for our leaves from our work and the office takes a lot of time to process the application.

If a fellow confirms that he is coming for fellowship programme then he should be provided with the contact details of the previous fellow from his country for further enquiry regarding the programme and for general information regarding Hong Kong, which are useful before coming here.

It is better if two fellows (if there are more applications in pipeline for consideration) from the same country are awarded the fellowship during the same period or with an overlapping period of at least 2 weeks.

Overall it was a great experience for me and definitely a very productive one for my career as a trauma surgeon in future.

Wish to continue my association with AADO in future also.
